WORRIES REST

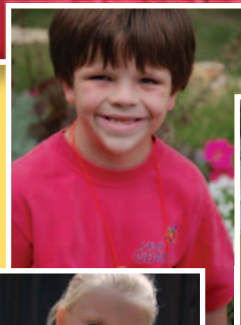

Camp Odayin's Day Camp is located at the Dodge Nature Center, 365 Marie Ave., West St. Paul, MN. The camp is located on 320 acres of diverse landscape. Dodge Nature Center also operates miles of hiking trails, prairie, and oak savanna restoration projects.

The beautiful heartland of Minnesota is home to Ojibwa people. Our camp derives its name from the Ojibwa word for heart.



Who can attend Camp Odayin?

Camp Odayin is for children with heart disease ages six and seven. Eligibility is determined upon recommendation by a pediatric cardiologist and approval by the Camp Odayin Medical Director.

When are camp sessions for 2007?

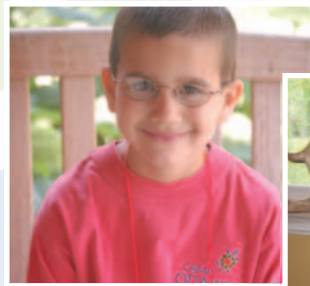
August 20-23 (Gitchee Gume: ages 6-7)
