Camp Odayin's residential camp is located 160 miles north of Minneapolis/St. Paul, Minnesota at the site of Camp Knutson. The full-service camp sits on a beautiful 30-acre peninsula of woodlands, surrounded by two of Minnesota's premier lakes on the Whitefish Chain. Free camper transportation is provided between the Twin Cities and Camp Odayin.

The beautiful heartland of Minnesota is home to Ojibwa people. Our camp derives its name from the Ojibwa word for heart.



## Who can attend Camp Odayin?

Camp Odayin's residential camp is for children with heart disease from ages 8-17. Eligibility is determined upon recommendation by a pediatric cardiologist and approval by the Camp Odayin medical and leadership teams. Typically, our campers see a cardiologist on a regular basis, are independent in living skills, and heart disease is their primary health concern. Most campers have had cardiac surgery and take daily cardiac medications.

## When are camp sessions for 2007?

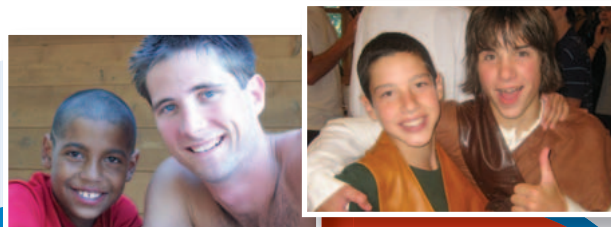
July 23-27 (Chippewa: ages 8-11)
